To preserve these natural materials, a few precautions are necessary.

Lighting

Wipe with a dry cloth.

Avoid contact with water and humidity. Brass, bronze and copper tend to develop a patina and oxidize over time.

Caution: fragile, rough and porous object that does not require special care.

Vases

Paola Paronetto

Each of Paola Paronetto's creations is unique.

From her own exclusive clay blend to the opaque, natural finish, each piece is made entirely by hand.

Slight variations in shape, color and size should be regarded as a guarantee of authenticity and value.

The vases are finished with non-toxic satin enamels. Although very rare, it is possible for them to leak after a long period of exposure to water. It is therefore advisable to test their water resistance before using them on delicate surfaces. They must not be used as tableware. Coloured pieces should be treated gently and cleaned with a feather duster or soft cloth, either dry or slightly dampened with water.

Rugs

Wool felt is easy to maintain because it doesn't get dirty easily: it doesn't collect dust and it produces less static electricity than other fibres.

- For regular maintenance, all you need to do is air the rugs outdoors to remove odours. They can be lightly brushed, preferrably with a silicone brush. The rugs can be vacuumed gently.
- To remove any stains, use a damp sponge with a mild soap solution.
 Depending on the nature of the stain, you may want to cover it with some bicarbonate of soda, or terre de Sommières (powdered clay). Dry cleaning is also possible.
- As the wool has not been chemically treated, we advice protecting the rugs from moths when the house is unoccupied for long periods. Virginia cedar wood oil is an excellent repellent.

Commercial moth repellent options are always available, although they are not organic... (to be renewed every three/four months)
