

Table and Chair Arrangements Maintenance Guide

All our tables, chairs and décor items are unique creations made-to-measure by our artisans.

Their exceptional quality will make them last for many years.

To preserve these natural materials, a few precautions are necessary.

Our wood species

Solid bleached oak, solid black ash, solid walnut

Maintenance: How to clean varnished wood:

- Dust removal: Clean the surface regularly with a soft cloth or feather duster to remove particles. Dust can scratch the surface over time.
- Gentle cleaning: For regular cleaning, use a cloth slightly dampened with lukewarm water. Avoid using too much water, as prolonged contact with water can damage the varnish.
- Cleaning products: If necessary, use a specific product for varnished wood. Be sure to follow the manufacturer's instructions and do not use abrasive products that could damage the varnish.
- Appropriate drying: After cleaning, dry the surface immediately with a clean, dry cloth to avoid water marks.
- Preventive maintenance: Keep your varnished wood furniture away from sources of excessive humidity and extreme temperature variations.

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Veneers

Plant-based leather

Use a cloth slightly dampened with water or a PH-neutral cleaner. Avoid abrasive products.

Stone veneer

All our tabletops are water-repellent (water, grease, oil). Avoid abrasive, toxic products, wax and any type of varnish. Use a sponge and neutral liquid soap.

Wood veneer

Carefully dab stains with a damp cloth and a cleaning product (1% detergent diluted solution). Avoid aggressive stain removers such as acetic acid.

Mosaic

Use a damp sponge or cloth. Avoid abrasive products.

Blotting paper

No special products are required for maintenance. A damp sponge or cloth is all you need. Do not use abrasive products.

Porcelain stoneware

Various types of stains can be treated with an alkaline detergent (drinks, food, ink, etc.). A solvent is recommended for candle wax or chewing gum.



Brass Finishings

• Gentle cleaning:

Use a soft, clean cloth to clean brass.

• Avoid Abrasive Products:

Do not use abrasive cleaning products, steel wool or hard-bristled brushes, as they may scratch the surface.

• Proper drying:

After cleaning, dry brass thoroughly to avoid water spots or marks.

Seat cushions

Plant-based leather

Use a cloth slightly dampened with water or a PH-neutral cleaner. Avoid abrasive products.

Bouclé fabric

Machine wash at 30°C, air dry and iron gently.

Woven fabric

Machine wash at 40°C and line-dry. Avoid machine spinning cycle and iron gently.
